**Extreme prophesy: January 7 - 28.** We examine God's power and justice as seen in the life of Elijah. In 1 Kings 17, God works through his prophet as He provides for Elijah and the widow at Zarephath. Session 2 shows God's power as Elijah faces the prophets of Baal, encouraging the young people to keep God at the centre of their lives and to acknowledge that he is the only one we can put our faith in. In session 3 (1 Kg 19) Elijah's encounter with God reminds us that we are not alone in fighting for God's justice even though at times it can seem that way. Finally, in the last session (1 Kg 21 and 22) we look at two kings: Ahab who deals with his people with injustice, and God who, in direct contrast, deals with his people with justice. Where we feel that we can do little to influence the world, people and events, the young people are reminded that nothing is beyond God's power.
