Radical networking: February 4 - 25. These sessions look at how meeting Jesus changes people's lives. In the first (John 3) Jesus tells Nicodemus that he needs to be born again. Being a Christian is about following Jesus, which means a radical change in our lives. His encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well (John 4: 3-42) shows that Jesus the Messiah knows all about us, yet still loves us. In the third session we see how Jesus heals the son of an important officer (John 4:43-54), showing that God's love and compassion go beyond physical limits, while the healing of the disabled man in the fourth session (John 5:1-18) teaches us that God's love and compassion may be shown in unexpected ways.
