Junior Church (Sundays, 10.30 - Contact Paul Demery 029 2076 2565).

Overturing the world order (April 1-15). These three sessions look at the Easter story from Matthew's Gospel and its implications for change in the world. In session 1 (Matt 21:1-17) we see Jesus enter Jerusalem and throw the money changers out of the temple - Palm Sunday. Jesus shows that God's way does not tolerate certain behaviour; it demands change, just as Jesus showed when he turned over the tables. Session 2 (Matt 28:1-10) deals with the events of Easter Sunday, when Jesus appears to the women at the tomb. Jesus' resurrection demonstrates the biggest ever change to the world order: Jesus has overturned death. Session 3 (Matt 28:16-20) looks at Jesus' commission to his disciples to share his good news with the world, and consider how that can bring about change.
